# **Application Procedure**

Papers' texts and applications for participation are required to submit through the registration form on the conference website <a href="http://dhconference.mgppu.ru/2022\_en">http://dhconference.mgppu.ru/2022\_en</a>:

- deadline for application for oral presentation and paper publication 18th September, 2022
- deadline for conference participation without oral presentation 15th November, 2022

Papers submitted for publication must contain original, nowhere published research results. The submitted texts must correspond to the theme of the conference and have not been previously published or to be under consideration in other publications. The originality of the text must be at least 70%, according to the results of the check using the "Antiplagiat.VUZ" system. Priority will be given to the presentation of the empirical research results.

The Program Committee reserves the right to select texts for publication, as well as the right to reject materials that do not correspond to the topics and aims of the conference and text formatting requirements.

## **Requirements paper text formatting**

- 1. File name should contain the number of session and first author last name: session\_number\_first\_author\_last\_name, for example: «1 Smith.docx».
- 2. The text must be in MS Word format in the style file of the conference proceedings in Russian (<u>Download\_Rus</u>) or in English (<u>Download\_Eng</u>). All formatting requirements are presented in the style files.
